



COACHES CODE OF CONDUCT

As a coach at Forfar Farmington Football Club you will be expected to abide by the following club rules:

- Allow all players, no matter their level of ability, the opportunity to develop as player
- Respect the rights, dignity & worth of every player and treat everyone equally within the context of football.
- Always pursue fair play
- Prohibit use of video/cameras unless parental consent has been provided
- Place safety and well-being of the player above the development of performance
- Be aware of the SFA's and the Club's Child Protection Policy and Procedures and complete the Child & Wellbeing Course
- Ensure that coaching sessions are enjoyable, well-structured and focus on developing skills, decision making and a general understanding of the game
- Develop an appropriate working relationship with players based on mutual trust and respect
- Encourage players to accept responsibility for their own behaviour and performance
- Ensure that sessions and games are appropriate for the age, maturity, experience and ability of the individual
- Must consistently display high standards of appearance and behaviour
- Bad language will not be tolerated at any time.
- Know where to find appropriate first-aid and ensure your team has a trained individual at all games. Report any incidents to First Aid rep for team to be recorded.
- Hold a current membership list and have a register available at all activities.
- Return all equipment/kit to Forfar Farmington FC before leaving the club.
- Make sure all fees are being paid and inform committee if any issues.
- Avoid communication with parents over social media and message, any issues suggest face to face meeting to avoid any conflict.

By registering as a coach with Forfar Farmington FC I agree to abide by these principles. I support the Club in its undertakings and encourage the Club to take any necessary disciplinary actions, where warranted, of any coaches, players, parents and or spectators for repeated or serious breaches of these Codes of Conduct.

PARENTS CODE OF CONDUCT

As a parent of a player of Forfar Farmington Football Club you will be expected to abide by the following club rules:

- Remember that you are there for the participants to enjoy the game.
- Encourage participation but don't force it.
- Teach that enjoyment is more important than winning.
- Never ridicule mistakes or losses – supporters are there to support not downgrade.
- Lead by example and respect all players, coaches, officials, referees and spectators – physical or verbal abuse will not be tolerated.
- Bad language will not be tolerated
- Recognise all volunteers who are giving up their valuable time, and offer support for matchday activities such as setting up equipment, coffee/tea stall.
- Support all club events and activities not just those of your team.
- >Avoid making contact with team coaches until a period of 24 hours has passed and allow time to reflect and arrange face to face discussion where necessary.
- Never publicly criticise coaches or referees – raise personal concerns with club officials in private.
- Don't use ugly remarks based on race, religion, gender or ability – you'll let down your family and yourself if you do & many such comments are actually now illegal.
- Pay any outstanding fees promptly
- Return all equipment/kit to Forfar Farmington FC before leaving the club.

PLAYERS CODE OF CONDUCT

As a player of Forfar Farmington Football Club you will be expected to abide by the following club rules:

- Play because you enjoy football and want to improve, not just to please anyone else.
- Respect other people and treat all players, including the opposition, equally, regardless of their colour, race, religion, sexual orientation or disability.
- Play within the rules of the sport
- Respect officials and their decisions, playing within the spirit of the game. (Without these people you can't play football)
- Set a good example at all times in aspects of language, behaviour and respect of equipment and facilities.
- Bad language will not be tolerated.
- Be committed to your team by showing good attendance at training sessions, being positive and motivating others.
- >Avoid making contact with team coaches until a period of 24 hours has passed and allow time to reflect and arrange face to face discussion where necessary.
- Keep to agreed timings for matches and training or inform their coach or team manager if they are going to be late or absent.
- Appreciate the efforts being put in by others on your behalf and show them due consideration and respect.
- Inform a member of the committee if there are any problems (medical or personal) that they should be aware of.
- Pay any fees for matches, training or events promptly.
- Return all equipment/kit to Forfar Farmington FC before leaving the club.
